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### **Meals on Wheels Celebrates March for Meals Month with Spaghetti Fundraiser**

Meals on Wheels-Anderson will host its spring Spaghetti Fundraiser on Thursday, March 15, 2012 as part of the March for Meals campaign.

Lunch will be available from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. Dinner will be available from 5 – 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$8 for adults and \$4 for children (12 and under). Meal includes spaghetti, salad, bread, dessert and tea.

March For Meals is a national campaign held during the month of March, initiated and sponsored by the Meals On Wheels Association of America (MOWAA), to raise awareness of senior hunger and to encourage action on the part of local communities. Programs like Meals on Wheels-Anderson promote March For Meals through public events, partnerships with local businesses, volunteer recruitment and fundraising initiatives.

The spaghetti dinner has been a tradition at Meals on Wheels-Anderson and is a twice-yearly event for the organization. Tickets may be purchased in advance at the MOW office or diners can pay at the door on the day of the fundraiser. Eat in our dining room or have your meals boxed for take-out. We accept cash, checks or credit cards. Meals on Wheels is located at 105 S. Fant Street, Anderson. Reservations for meals are not required.
