### SHELF STABLE MEALS PROGRAM

Each winter, we face the possibility of days that we are unable to send out hot meals due to inclement weather or icy roadways.

As winter approaches we send a ready-to-eat package of food called a "shelf stable meal" to each Meals on Wheels recipient to use if we cannot deliver a hot meal.

You can help us get ready by collecting the following items and placing them in a gallon-

size zipper-seal plastic bag so they will be easy for our route drivers to distribute.

One shelf stable meal bag should contain:

- Ready to eat canned soup (not the kind that needs water added)
- Nutri-grain bar or granola bar
- Individual canned or boxed juice drink (no

grapefruit or energy drinks)

- Individual box of raisins
- Individual container of fruit

Meal packages may be brought to the Meals on Wheels Center, 105 S. Fant Street. Hours of operation are Monday-Thursday, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., Friday, 8 a.m.-2 p.m.
